 (9 – 13 units per term)

A maximum of 70 semester units (or 105 quarter units) are transferable from a community college. The Art History plan requires 87 units and 180 are needed for graduation. Depending on how many units are transferred, you may need to take ‘free electives’ to meet the 180 total units for graduation.

(16 units of General Education requirements must be fulfilled since they are upper division courses)
