BA Art History/ Plan III  
 (10 - 13 units per term)

A Maximum of 70 semester units (or 105 quarter units) are transferable from a community college. Art Major requires 82 units and 180 are needed for graduation. Depending on how many units are transferred, you may need to take 'free electives' to meet the 180 total graduation units.

16 units of General Education requirements must be fulfilled since they are upper division units.
